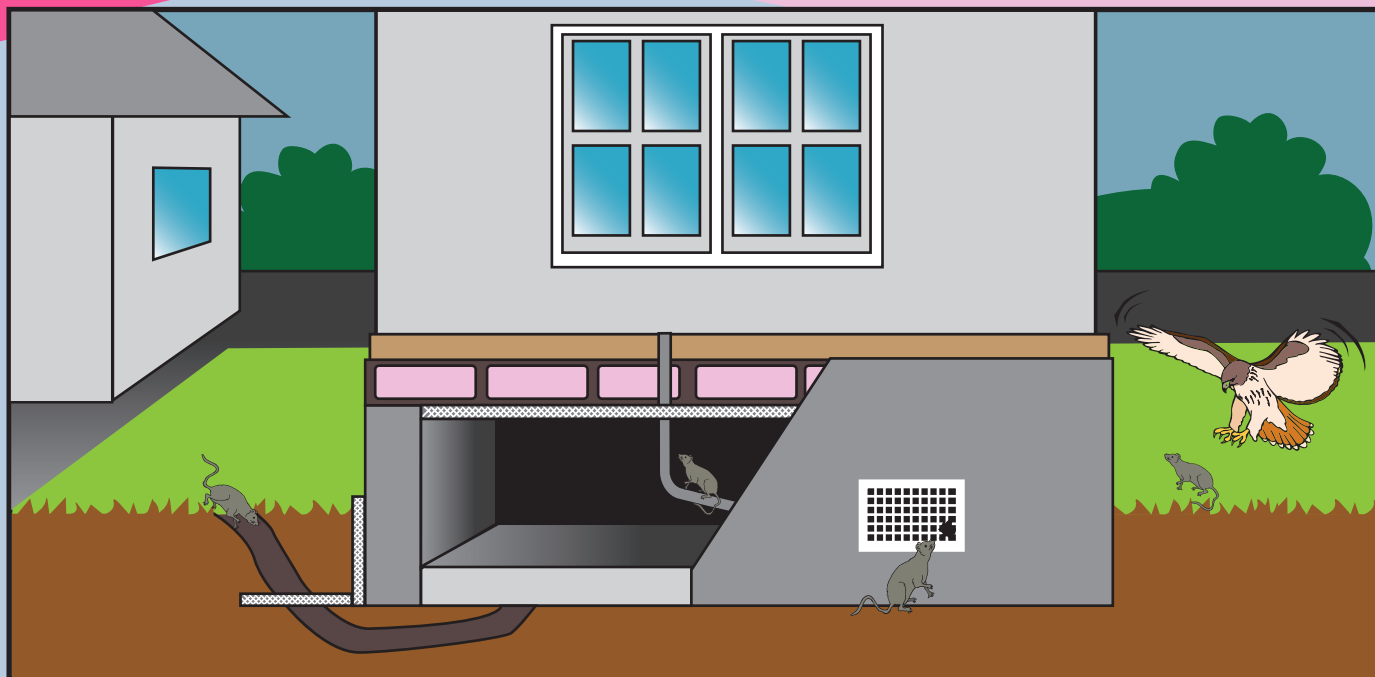


Got RATS in your CRAWL SPACE?



Here are some tips to prevent them without poison.



MANAGE THE RODENTS: NORWAY RATS ARE AGGRESSIVE TUNNELERS

1. Continuously trap and remove rodents.
2. Regularly inspect for new entry points and seal them up.
3. Backfill tunnels to discourage digging.

PERMANENT SOLUTIONS

1. Rodent-proof the insulation by sealing off your joists with galvanized steel mesh. The insulation and living area are protected even if rodents enter the crawl space.
2. Bury galvanized steel mesh along the foundation (known as a trench and screen) to block tunneling.
3. Install a layer of concrete (known as a rat slab) to block tunneling.
